Caring for your Doll Parts garments:

Washing Lingerie Pieces

To preserve delicate fabrics like power mesh, tulle or lace, we recommend you hand wash your Doll Parts pieces. Use cold water and a gentle detergent. Avoid using bleach as it may cause damage to the fabric and/or elastics. For silk sets and garments it is best to rely on professional dry cleaning services.

<u>Cleaning Corsets</u>

We strongly recommend you do not wash your Doll Parts corsets in water as the boning is made from stainless steel and may develop rust. To clean corsets, we recommend professionally dry cleaning or if it just needs a freshening up, spraying the inside lining with vodka and hanging to dry.

Additionally, many of our corsets are made from hand-dyed silk, never use bleach.

Drying & Hanging

We recommend hanging your Doll Parts garments inside and away from direct sunlight to dry. This is particularly important with corsets and hand-dyed pieces. Dry your corset completely before storing and hang over a pants hanger or with a skirt hanger.

Ironing

For silk (non-corset) pieces, you can use a steamer to gently iron out any wrinkles. We do not recommend using an iron directly on mesh or tulle pieces as they may melt with high heat. Do not iron corsets.
